	Activity	Guidance for Parents
1 	<p>Science: Do you know what season we are in? Summer. How do you know? What changes are there in summer compared to other seasons? e.g. different clothes, trees, plants, warmer weather. In the summer we also have longer days and shorter nights which is measured by the number of daylight hours. Look at the table (attached) that compares daylight hours.</p> <p>Create a list of changes in the summer and compare them to another season of your choice (written or pictorial representation)</p>	<p>Questions for discussion: Which month(s) has the most daylight hours? Which month(s) has the least daylight hours? Which months are Summer? Can you add up the daylight hours for summer? Each season?</p>
2 	<p>RE: This week we are going to learn about St Francis of Assisi. Do you remember what a Saint is? Saint Francis of Assisi is the patron saint of animals and nature. Watch the video</p> <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=sUhZI9F1W-8</p> <p>Draw a picture of Saint Francis with his 'brothers and sisters' i.e. animals, birds, nature</p>	<p>Remind your child how we have different Saints representing our house teams in school. Can they remember who they are? St David, St Patrick, St Andrew and St George.</p>
3 	<p>Computing: E-Safety Do you remember what it means to be safe on the internet? Why is it important? Read the story about Digiduck's Famous Friend</p> <p>https://www.childnet.com/resources/digiduck-stories/digiducks-famous-friend</p> <p>Why was Digiduck excited to go to school? Why does the mystery guest not answer Proud.pig's question? Why were Digiduck and his friends surprised to see Wise-Owl on the stage? What did you learn from the story about staying safe online?</p>	<p>The aim of this activity is to remind your child how to stay safe on the internet, especially if they have been spending more time recently online.</p>
