



Lessons 1 and 2 will be taught at school. whatever days your child attends. This means you can work on activities 3 and 4 from home on your 'off' days.
If you are continuing to learn from home, then you can work through the activities in whichever order you wish 😊

Lesson	Activity	Guidance for Parents
1 Geography	Let's look at habitat. We enjoyed finding out where different sea creatures lived and learning about their habitat last week. Let's look at the picture, can you sort out which animals live in the ocean, which live on the land. Have a look at the different animals, can you explain what is different about the animals, is there something all the animals in the ocean have in common?	There is a sheet attached to cut and stick the animals. You could ask the children to draw the animals and make their own chart. Encourage them to think about what is different about the animals and where they live. You could also talk about where they stick the pictures- next to, under- what position they are in the picture.
2 Singing	Let's join in some singing about the ocean and seas. There is a video and words for you to join in with our singalong. They might be new songs, but you should know the tunes. I hope you enjoy. 😊 Our last singing session of the term will be about farm animals- if you have any songs you would like us to sing- let us know on tapestry. 😊	There is a separate video with the song session on. See if your child can remember any other songs about the sea or things that live in the sea?
3 P.E	Our theme this week in P.E. is 'In the Jungle' Last week we heard the music 'The Jungle.' Can you remember what animals we thought about. Here are some suggestions to help you move. Elephant- heavy stomping movements for the elephant. Snake- changes of direction for the slithering snake. Tiger- soft and slow prowling movements for the tiger Monkey, Butterfly, Frog- what movements are you going to make for these?	There is a video to give guidance on how they could act and move to 'The Jungle' There is a music file as well to encourage their own interpretation. Remember to encourage them to warm up and cool down too.
4 Science	What shall we wear? Last week we were measuring the weather. Have you thought about how the weather affects what we wear? There is an activity with Seren, can you choose the right clothes for the different seasons? You could think about your clothes at home and put on different things to show how you know what to wear for the different seasons- take some photos Or you could draw pictures to show what to wear. Think about the clothes you really like and would choose to wear when it is raining or super sunny.	Helping children know what to wear, whatever the weather is important. Their bodies are still adapting to temperatures and they don't always know when they are too hot or cold. Talk about the different clothes they like wearing, how they might wear different things depending on the weather. How do they know what the weather is going to be like?
