- ABC Order-** Write out the spelling list in alphabetical order.
 - Word Parts** - Write your words. Then use a coloured pencil to divide the words into syllables. e.g.
jumping
Caterpillar
 - Vowel Spotlight** - Write your words using one colour for the vowels and another colour for the consonants. (vowels: a, e, I, o, u)
 - Other Hand** - Write each word 5 times, switching the hand you write it with each time. Say the word as you spell it.
