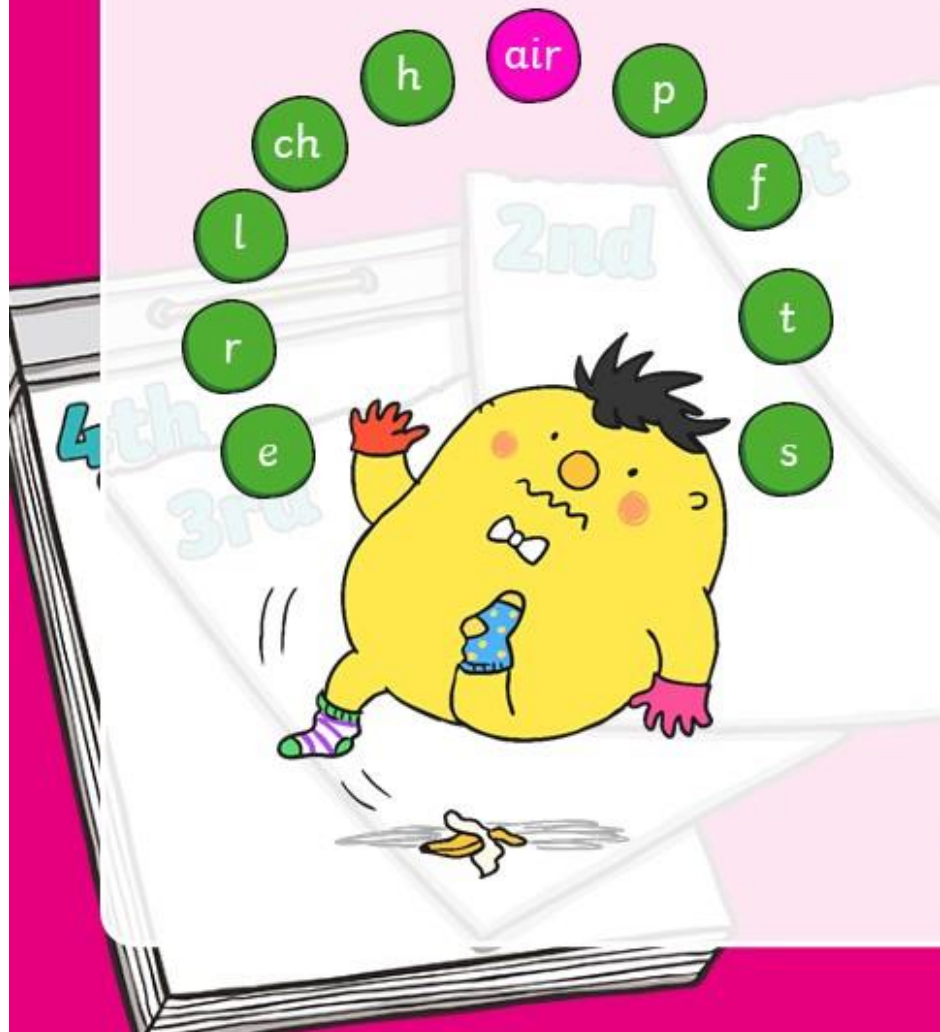

How many real words can you make?

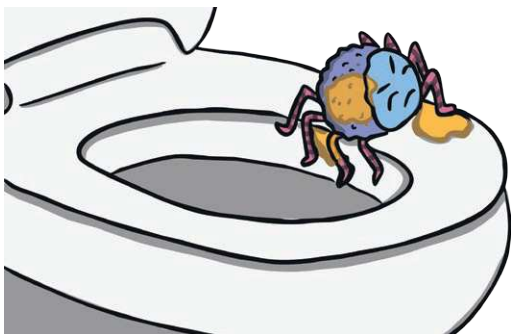
Villainous Verses
