

The sleepover

We hope that the following information will help you understand a little more about the sleepover and reassure you in preparation for the event.

What will children need for the evening:

We will provide children with a mat to sleep on. They can bring an additional mat if they would like to sleep on, but due to the number of children and space that we have we will not be able to accommodate inflatable beds this year.

Children will need something to wear to sleep in

A toothbrush and toothpaste

Clothes for Saturday morning

A cuddly toy or teddy bear- if they would like, and a reading book.

Everything else will be provided, including snacks.

A water bottle.

No electronics are allowed.

What happens on the evening:

When the children arrive at 6.30pm, they will put their bags at the side of the hall and then complete a number of supervised arts and craft activities.

At drop off you will be asked to hand in medical forms (if not already handed to class teachers) and hand over any medication/information to staff who will be on the desk.

We will stop activities and enjoy some food before going outside for some outdoor fun, which will include a mixture of games and activities.

Once we return to the hall, we will set up our 'beds' Children will then get changed before they settle down to watch the movie.

Children will use their normal classroom toilets throughout the sleepover, where they are familiar and classroom lights will be kept on throughout the evening.

Staff will stay within the hall and the corridor so that they will see any children that get up in the night.

If your child is unwell, we will follow normal school procedures and call you if they need to be collected.

On Saturday morning children will get dressed and go and brush their teeth before packing away their belongings. Depending on the time, they will then go out to play whilst breakfast is prepared. Children will be offered a range of items for breakfast including pain au chocolate, croissants, yogurts and fruit.

Parents will collect children at 9am from the front entrance. A member of staff will be on the door and will let parents in to collect children from the hall.

Communication- we will use the text system to send updates via text.

Security- All doors will be locked so the school will be secure. Mrs Blakeley will 'rest' by the entrance.
