



## P.E - Cricket skills

### The overarm challenge

**How to Play:** Set up a wicket (or a similar shaped target) to throw at. At intervals, place cones in a line stretching back from the wicket (with the first cone at the shortest distance from the stumps). The aim of the game is simple - throw a ball overarm to hit the wicket. After each successful throw, the player moves further back to the next cone and tries again.

**History:** To show my understanding and knowledge of Ancient Egyptian life

This week, we will be focusing on seeds.

### You will need:

- Seeds such as radish or mustard
- Small growing containers
- Soil

**Task:** Grow a seed, e.g. radish or mustard seed, in a small container such as a film canister filled with soil.

The aim is for the seed to germinate within a few days so that you can take the seedling out and name parts of the plant such as seed, seed case, root, shoot, root hairs and stem.




Focus: Ancient Egyptians
